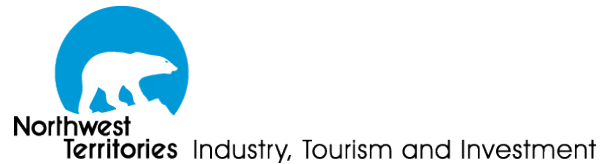


BULLETIN



Minister of Industry, Tourism and Investment David Ramsay hereby calls for nominations on Territorial Reserve Lands north of 60° in the Central Mackenzie Valley and the Mackenzie Delta/Arctic Islands. Companies interested in obtaining petroleum exploration rights are asked to nominate blocks of lands which they would like to see in a subsequent Call for Bids. All posting requests must be described in accordance with the *Guidelines for Posting Parcels North of Latitude 60° N*. Lands currently under licence which revert to Commissioner reserve status during the course of this Call for Nominations may also be nominated.

All Aboriginal sub-surface lands established pursuant to land claim agreements are excluded from the lands available for posting.

The identity of the nominator is kept strictly confidential.

Central Mackenzie Valley

Despite containing one of Canada's largest oil fields at Norman Wells, the Mackenzie Valley remains lightly explored and offers opportunities to make new and potentially large discoveries of both oil and gas. The region includes lands covered by both the *Gwich'in Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement* and the *Sahtu Dene and Metis Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement*.

Mackenzie Delta/Arctic Islands

The Mackenzie Delta/Arctic Islands hold vast potential for gas and oil. Relatively quiet in terms of exploration activity in the past few years, interest in discovering the true potential of the region is increasing once more. The region includes lands covered by the *Inuvialuit Final Agreement* and the *Gwich'in Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement*.

Call for Bids

The exercise of petroleum exploration rights is subject to specific terms and conditions relating to the environment and must comply with requirements under land claim agreements and for northern benefits. This information is contained in the proposed 2014-2015 Call for Bids Exploration Licences and within the terms of the Exploration Licence.

Should nominations be received, a Call for Bids for nominated blocks may be launched in December 2014.
